Nursery places

We still have a number of Nursery places available and would love to have more families come to join us. Please contact us if you would like to consider your child joining our Nursery.

Admissions

Please remember to apply for your child's Secondary or Reception place by the 31st October.

After School Clubs

We have a variety of clubs that are run by our very talented members of staff. Staff give up their time to ensure that these clubs run and I would ask that parents support is in ensuring that once a child makes the commitment to join a club that they continue to attend a club.

There are a number of places available for clubs. If your child hasn't signed up to a club, please contact the school office so that we can add their name to the register. Children can be collected from the school playground at 4pm.

If there is not a club suitable for your child, then you might want to access our After School Care between the hours of 3-5pm. This provision is run by Jan and Tina. If children are staying beyond 4pm they will be entitled to a snack. Children staying until 4pm can be collected from the school yard and those collecting at 5pm can collect their children via the main entrance. The cost of the care is £3 per hour. This is a fantastic service that has been fully used and utilized in the last academic year. However, there has been fewer parents using the service. I hope that parents would carefully consider using this as this is service as it is something that we would not want to lose. Please book your child's place through Parentpay.

Punctuality

There have been a few children who are arriving after the register closes at 8.50am this week. If your child is over 20 minutes late they are given a U code which means that they were late after the register closed. Please be aware that if your child is late a total of 14 times in a total of 12 weeks then this is automatically referred to the Local Authority and you could be at risk of receiving a fine.

Please remember we have a Bounce Breakfast that starts at 8am to encourage children to arrive at school on time. It costs £1 and is free for children entitled to Free School Meals.

Uniform (including P.E. uniform)

I would just like to take the opportunity to remind parents and children of the importance and the pride that they should take when wearing their school uniform.

This information is taken from our prospectus and it has not changed:

Here at The Grove Primary, we are extremely proud of our school identity and all children wear the school uniform with pride. Our school uniform consists of a white polo or collared shirt, red jumper with school badge, black or grey trousers (not jogging trousers) or skirts and black shoes. Children need to wear sensible flat shoes for school (no branded trainers). We promote independence throughout school for all our children and children need to be able to take off and put on their own shoes without adult support, therefor Velcro fastening shoes can be worn by children who are unable to tie shoe laces.

Our school PE kit consists of: team coloured t shirt with embroidered school logo and shorts. School uniform and PE kits can be purchased from the school office. Some classes will be having outdoor P.E. and must have appropriate clothing to go outside (long trousers and a long sleeved top/jumper). This information can be found on your child's newsletter whether they will be indoors or outdoors. Children must have a P.E. kit in school at all times.

We will **not permit** children to wear any jewellery apart from a watch for health and safety purposes. If children wear jewellery, they will be asked to remove it and place it into their bags.

We also ask that children with longer hair (including Nursery children) have their hair tied back so that hair does not get caught on/in equipment.
