# Welcome Back!

We hope you have all had a wonderful summer holiday! It is lovely to see all of the children and their families after the summer break!

#### The Reception children look so smart in their new uniforms!

Thank you to those of you who have taken the time to put your child's name in their uniform. If any of you haven't done this yet, please do it ASAP as it really helps to prevent items of clothing from going missing. As a reminder, children in Reception need to wear <u>black shoes</u> for school. Nursery children can wear any coloured shoes, but please do not send your children in lace up shoes unless they can fasten them by themselves.

### Wellington Boots

A **HUGE** thank you to all of you who have sent your child's wellies in for the year. Every child must have their own pair of wellies in school. The wellies will stay in school and we will let you know when your child has grown out of them. If you have not already sent in a pair of wellies for your child, please do so ASAP. Remember to clearly label each welly with your child's name. Thank you.

#### P.E.in EYFS

One of the main elements in P.E. for early years children is to be independent when it comes to dressing and undressing.

Nursery have P.E. on Tuesday mornings. Please avoid putting Nursery children in tights on a Tuesday as they can be very tricky for the children to manage.

Reception have PE on Monday afternoons. Please ensure that Reception children have their PE kits in school with some PE shoes included in this. If your child struggles to get changed, please support them at home by practising changing their own clothes.

As always, please ensure your child's name is written in every piece of their P.E. kit and check it regularly to ensure that it is still visible as names can often fade in the wash.



This year, we are moving to electronic journals. We are currently trialling 'Tapestry'. A benefit of this is that you will receive notifications of what your child has been up to in Early Years and you can view their profile anytime using your unique log in. It also means that you can send us pictures and messages about what they have been up to outside of school. We are really excited about it! Please ensure that you have signed the consent form and returned it to school ASAP.

If your child arrives in school wearing earrings they will be asked to remove them and if they can't do so themselves, a parent/carer will be contacted and asked to come into
