School Dinners

From September, those families who pay for school dinners the cost will be £2.10 per school meal. This can be paid via ParentPay.

Library Books

We have a book box outside of the main entrance so that families can return any library/reading books to school. Please return yours as soon as possible; thank you!

Reports

Reports can be collected from school (car park) next Wednesday 8th July. Each family's reports will be in one envelope. Each family will have an allocated time to collect their family's envelope which will be based on the oldest child in each family. For example, the oldest child might be in Year 3 so parents will collect between 10 and 10.30am or if the oldest child is in Year 5 that family would collect between 9 and 9.30am and so on.

Any families who receive Free School Meals, your voucher will be in the envelope too. Please keep to your allocated time to allow us to keep all of our families safe. If you are unable to collect on Wednesday, please contact the school office to arrange collection.
