

Could you be entitled to Free School Meals (FSM)?

Any child may qualify for a free school meal if you receive one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual earnings threshold that does not exceed £7,400.
- Income Support.
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance.
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.
- Child Tax Credit (provided a parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit) and have an annual income, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs, that does not exceed £16,190.
- Working Tax Credit run on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.

How do we check?

To see if you are eligible we would run a confidential check. We would need:

- ✓ Full name
- ✓ Date of Birth
- ✓ National Insurance number
- ✓ We will ask you which benefit you access.

If your application is successful your child will receive:

- ✓ A Free school dinner/ packed lunch everyday
- ✓ Additional funding to help support their learning in school.
