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**Our Ref: Information for Parents Autumn 2**

Dear Parents/Carers

As you will be fully aware, the Prime Minister has announced that a national lockdown will start from 00.01am on Thursday 5 November for four weeks until Wednesday 2 December, subject to the parliamentary process.

Under the new restrictions:

- People will be told to stay at home except for specific reasons. These include work which cannot be
  done from home, childcare or education, exercise outdoors, medical reasons, essential shopping,
  providing care for vulnerable people or for volunteering, and visiting members of your 'support
  bubble'.
- Meeting indoors or in private gardens will not be allowed unless part of your household or 'support bubble', but individuals can meet one other person from another household outside in a public place.
- Schools and universities will remain open.
- Children will still be able to move between homes if their parents are separated.
- Overnight stays, staying in a second home, and holidays will not be allowed including in the UK and abroad although there are exceptions, such as work trips.
- Non-essential travel by private or public transport will not be allowed.

I would also like to remind parents that we only permit one adult to drop off and pick up from school. This should be a family member and not another parent. Parents are also asked not to congregate at the gates and to mindful of social distancing recommendations. This is at the gate and on the playground when children are dismissed.

When working with children this week, staff have reported children have said that they have been 'playing/going for tea' to other children's houses. Just to remind parents that this is not permitted under the new restrictions and that children should remain at home when they come home from school.

# Picking up/Dropping off

We try to run a one-way system to ensure that the drop off and collection is as safe as possible for all of our families. We would ask that parents continue to do this even though the start and the end to the school day is staggered. Children with surnames A-M your drop off time is between 8.30 - 8.40am and collection time is 2.50-3.00pm (Reception to Year 6 children). Those children with surnames N-Z drop off time is between 8.40-8.50am and collection is at 3pm (Reception to Year 6 children).
