#### Dear Parents/Carers

Just a few pieces of information to share this week with you all. We would ask you to encourage other parents to read the newsletter that is usually sent on a weekly basis.

## **Book Bags**

Moving forward from Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September, children will be able to bring and take home their red books bags daily. We hope this will promote independence of children bringing the things they need to school and also help to promote reading as children will have their books with them every day at school and then at home on the evening.

Children will be able to also use their books bags to bring home any information, letters, jumpers daily. We would ask that parents/carers continue to only send the essentials into school which currently is: Reading Records and reading books.

The reading for pleasure books children can keep at home and then return them when they need to change them.

Staff listen to children read so it is important to remember their books bags every day.
