#### Winter Vouchers

The Local Authority are going to provide Winter Vouchers to support families, in receipt of free school meals, to support with household bills over the winter period. We are hoping that these will be sent to school so that we can share them with families before the Christmas holidays. Each child entitled will receive a voucher of £60.

## Dogs in the playground

We would kindly like to remind parents that dogs are not permitted in school grounds even on a lead.

#### Children walking to school

Children in Years 3 to Year 6 can be given permission to walk to school. We would ask that any children younger than Year 3 be accompanied to school by an adult. We are unable to allow older siblings to walk younger siblings to school.

If parents/carers would like to promote independence, may I suggest that children in Year 1 and upwards be allowed to walk to their entry point from the school gates. Please remember that each entry point has an adult to greet children each morning. Any questions or queries can be directed to a member of staff and these will be passed on to the relevant staff member. Thank you.

# Traffic along Oakfield Lane

- We kindly ask that parents and carers dropping off and collecting follow the one- way system to alleviate congestion.
- We also ask that cars do not park opposite the school gates so children and families can cross safely.
- Parents/carers should adhere to the staggered timings when dropping off (only 8.30am for Nursery and their siblings) and 8.35-8.50am for all other children.
- Please also consider your speed as you drive along Oakfield Lane.
- Lastly, we would ask that parents do not sit for long periods of time, along Oakfield Lane, with their engines running waiting to collect children.
