Dear Parents/Carers

There is a growing number of families where adults and children have tested positive for covid as the month has gone on. We would ask that children's results (LFD and PCR) are shared via enquiries and in line with guidance; 2 consecutive negative lateral flow tests from Day 5. Children still testing positive after this can return after Day 10. It is important that guidance is followed to keep all in our school community safe.



Nursery Places

We would like to remind parents that when they choose our Nursery we would hope that they would apply for a Reception place too. This supports transitions as children use similar routines in Nursery and Reception and will have made relationships and friendships with staff and children too.

Please note that although Nursery education is not statutory we would ask that parents do not request a leave of absence during term time in line with the rest of the school. Staff work hard to prepare resources and interventions so we would ask that Nursery children attend as often as possible and if children are well enough to do so.

After School Club Price Increase- 31st January 2022
