Dear Parents/Carers

It has been a tough start to 2022 to say the least and a tiring half term for all. School Lunch Price Increase-April 2022

We have been informed that the price of a school meal will increase on Monday 4th April. The cost of a daily school meal will be £2.20.

There are few changes to the summer menu (which will begin on Monday 25th April). We will be sharing the summer menus with parents and children after half term.

If your child changes from a school meal to a packed lunch or vice versa, we ask that you give us a week's notice by contacting the school office.

Nursery Places

Did you know that you can apply for a Nursery place when your child turns two? They will then start on the term after their third birthday. Please see https://www.thegroveprimaryschool.co.uk/ourclasses/nursery/ for admission forms and any additional information.

We would like to remind parents that when they choose our Nursery we would hope that they would apply for a Reception place too. This supports transitions as children use similar routines in Nursery and Reception and will have made relationships and friendships with staff and children too.

Please note that although Nursery education is not statutory we would ask that parents do not request a leave of absence during term time in line with the rest of the school. Staff work hard to prepare resources and interventions so we would ask that Nursery children attend as often as possible.
