#### Year 6 Assembly

We would ask that parents arrive from 1.05pm (via pupil entrance) tomorrow if they are coming to the Year 6 Assembly. There is limited space in the hall and Year 6 children and any siblings can leave after the assembly. Parents will be asked to wait outside while children are being dismissed.

## Allensford visit- Year 4,5 and 6 visit

We will be taking children to Allensford for our annual visit. While we are there, children will play games, play in water and can visit the shop. We will stay at Allensford all day but will be back to school for home time.

We will walk there and back along the heritage trail. Children should come to school dressed for this (non- uniform) wearing comfortable shoes.

- ✓ Some children like to wear swimming costume/ shorts under their clothing.
- ✓ SPARE Shoes that can get wet

Children will be no doubt getting wet and dirty so don't send children in their best clothes! Once they have done the water activities they will change into dry clothes for the walk home.

We will be going on **Monday 18th July** and children have class challenges to earn money to go. As always children with poor behaviour may risk not being able to come so we are expecting children to have worked hard in these last few weeks to earn their privilege to take part. Any poor behaviour shown at Allensford would result in that child returning to school early. In the event of very poor weather we will make a plan on the day so that children still receive a reward but maybe in a drier environment... pray for sunshine everyone!

If children normally have a packed lunch they should bring one that day. All children who have school dinners are having a very special lunch prepared and delivered to Allensford from the school kitchen!

All children will know when they leave school on Friday if they have enough money to take part and so they will be able to tell you if they need to bring a change of clothes on Monday.
