Platinum Jubilee Celebrations

It has been fantastic to see all of the photos that have been shared with classes- via Tapestry- for the jubilee celebrations to help children to understand about their decade.

Each class has been assigned a decade to learn about in the week beginning the 23rd May (Year 6-1950s, Year 5-1960s, Year 4-1970s, Year 3-1980s, Year 2-1990s, Year 1-2000s, Early Years-2000 to present).
