Support for families

We continue to try and support our families in any way we can during these difficult times by continuing to try and keep the cost of the school day down. We are trying different ways to ensure we reach all of our families that need a little extra help throughout the year. Previously, we gave families bags of shopping to cover the school holidays, but sometimes these weren't collected or didn't suit the needs of the families. We are trying to move into having a rolling foodbank type of supply of staple items in school to help everyone 'as and when'.
