#### Year 6 Assembly- Wednesday 19th July at 1.30pm

We would ask that parents arrive from 1.15pm (via pupil entrance) on Wednesday 19th July if they are coming to the Year 6 Assembly. There is limited space in the hall and Year 6 children and any siblings can leave after the assembly. Parents will be asked to wait outside while children are being dismissed.

#### After School Club/Breakfast Club

The last day for our After School Club will be Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> July until 4.30pm. There will be no After School Club on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July.

Breakfast and After School Club will return on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022 when the school opens after the summer holidays. The form for After School Club will be sent out on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023.

Please remember that there will be an increase, in cost, for After School Club sessions from September. It will be £5.00 from 3.15-4.15pm and £7.50 from 3.15pm-4.30pm.

#### **Playgroup**

Tomorrow will be our last playgroup session for this academic year. Thank you to all of our dedicated volunteers and staff who continue to make our Community Playgroup a success. We hope that you all have a well-deserved rest over the summer holidays!

#### **Book bags**

Our red book bags are compulsory for all children (including Nursery). We ask for book bags because these can be easily stored and is the best way to transport reading books and any work completed by your child/ren. #### **School dinners**

From September, a daily school dinner will cost £2.50 (weekly £12.50 paid via ParentPay). Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children are all entitled to a Free School Meal through the Universal Free School Entitlement.

Some families, throughout school, could be entitled to Free School meals if you meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Universal Credit with an annual earnings threshold that does not exceed £7,400.
- Income Support.
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance.
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.
- Child Tax Credit (provided a parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit) and have an annual income, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs, that does not exceed £16,190.
- Working Tax Credit run on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
- Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
