Payment for non-uniform days

As you will be aware, we are now a cashless school. Moving forward, we would ask that all donations (£1) for non- uniform days are paid via ParentPay (School Fund). This monthly donation will help to subsidise visits and experiences for our children. If you are having issues getting signed up to ParentPay, please contact the school office and we will be able to offer some support.

Dismissal time

The end of the school day, for all children, is 3.15pm. The gates will now open at 3.10pm each day for anyone collecting children from school. Please pass this information to other family members and childminders who collect from school. Thank you

Reception places- Closing date 15th January 2024

Just a reminder that if your child will be turning 4 years old between 1st September 2023 and 31st August 2024, they will start Reception in September 2024. You must apply for their school place NOW.

Children do not automatically receive a Reception school place, even if they are already attending our nursery. Individual schools have no part in this process and you must apply through Durham County Council.

The deadline for applications is Monday 15th January 2024. If you miss the deadline your child may not receive a place at your preferred school.

Attendance queries

We have had some parents query appointments and the affect on attendance. These are authorised but still impact on your child's attendance figures. It is always best to try and arrange appointments as close to the end of the school day- where possible- to have the least impact on attendance percentages.
