Pick Up/ Drop off

Thank you to those parents who have requested to open both gates for all at 8.30am. As we only have one entrance, we simply do not have enough space to allow parents to drop Nursery children off while allowing all other parents to drop off too.

Just to clarify for all parents/carers and family members dropping off, our gates open at 8.30am so that we can accommodate the Nursery children's 15 and 30 hour placement timings. Nursery children's siblings can also arrive at 8.30am so drop off is easier for families who have Nursery (am/30 hours) children.
