Dear Parents/Carers,

We have lots to share and look forward to in the last few weeks before half-term which we have included below in today's newsletter.

Year 4 visit- Monday 9th October

Year 4 are all so excited for our trip to the Roman Wall on Monday 9th October- they have a busy day planned. They will be visiting The Roman Army Museum and Vindolanda, which was a Roman fort. If the weather is kind, they will take a walk up on to the wall so children can see what it would have been like to be a Roman soldier patrolling the wall.

Children will not need to wear school uniform, but they will need to be prepared for an Autumn Day. This will mean having a warm, waterproof coat and old trainers or wellies. Fiona went at the weekend and in some places the walk to the wall was muddy, but not too bad.

The gift shop was very expensive and small so the children do not need to bring money. They would also not have time to go as there is so much to do!

The staff will be taking lots of photos and will get them uploaded as soon as they can.

Illness
